About us...

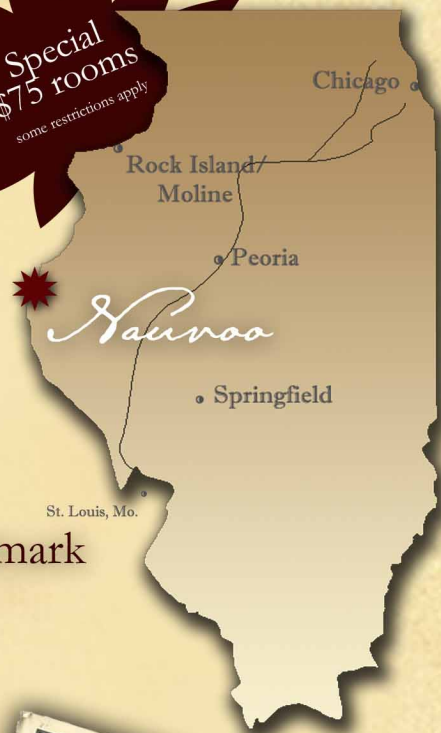
Nauvoo is located in West Central Illinois along the majestic Mississippi River, nestled on the Great River Road.
